DAAD SPONSORED FELLOWSHIPS FOR SUB-SAHARAN AFRICAN NATIONALS

The Federal Government of Germany through the German Academic Exchange Programme (DAAD) shall offer a limited number of fellowships tenable at the University of Botswana in 2017/2018 academic year. The fellowships will be in the Masters of Public Administration (MPA) programme.

Master's Degree in Public Administration (10 fellowships)

The programme of study shall be offered for the award of the Master's Degree in Public Administration (MPA). The following streams are currently offered: MPA Human Resources Management, MPA Public Policy and Administration, MPA Public Sector Financial Management, MPA Local Government Management and MPA Environmental Science Management.

Entrance Qualifications

1. The minimum entrance requirement for the DAAD fellowship shall be a Bachelor's degree in the Social Sciences, Public Administration, with at least a **second class upper** division or equivalent (3.5CGPA).
2. Must have completed their last degree less than six years ago at the time of application.
3. Must be nationals of a Sub-Saharan African country, excluding Botswana nationals.

Female applicants and candidates from less privileged regions or groups will be specially encouraged to participate in the programme.

Financial Support

Fellowships are partial and cover tuition, monthly stipend, medical insurance, book allowance and travel subsidy. Fellowships are awarded to Sub-Saharan African Nationals (excluding those in the country of the host institution).
